ASSEMBLING THE DRAIN COVER INLAY LID

INSTALL

CIRCULAR SAW



ANGLE GRINDER




TAPE MEASURE



CAULKING GUN MARKER













SELECT INLAY

Select defect-free inlay materials that match the landscape surrounds.



CUT INLAY TO SIZE

Cut inlay material to fit inside the Inlay Lid allowing for a 1mm clearance on all sides.


Note: If using tumbled/ chiselled edge tile/stone cut all 4 edges for a better finish.



CUT A KEYWAY

Mark the centre on the inlay material (A) edge. At the centre point, mark a cut 6mm (w) x 25mm (l).

Use an angle grinder (for stone/tiles) to cut through the full tile height.







CLEAN THE CUT INLAY


Rinse well with water to remove ALL cutting dust.



DRY THE CUT INLAY

Allow inlay material to dry fully BEFORE proceeding.





FAILURE TO COMPLETE THESE STEPS MAY RESULT IN A WEAK ADHESIVE BOND.




CALCULATE ADHESIVE REQUIRED


CALCULATE:


Inlay Lid (B) minus Height of Inlay Material (A) equals

HEIGHT DIFFERENCE.

The HEIGHT DIFFERENCE determines the amount of adhesive to place on the inside of the Inlay Lid (B).







with the Height Adjuster, remember there will be two lots of adhesive applied ie. adhesive is applied inside the Inlay Lid (B) AND the reverse side of the inlay material (A).




AVOID PLACING ANY ADHESIVE WITHIN 10MM OF THE KEYWAY.




APPLY ADHESIVE + ASSEMBLE

NO HEIGHT ADJUSTER:


Adhesive is only applied inside the Inlay Lid (B). Flip Inlay Lid (B) over and press down onto reverse side of the inlay material (A).





WITH HEIGHT ADJUSTER:

Adhesive is applied inside the Inlay Lid (B) AND the reverse side of the inlay material (A). Flip Inlay Lid (B) over and press down as shown below.





LEVEL OFF

Ensure the materials fitted into the Inlay Lid are sitting flush with the top of the Lid. If not, gently press down until they are. Then wait 15 mins while adhesive

stiffens.





ADJUST INLAY MATERIALS

Flip assembled lid over.

Adjust the inlay materials to be centred within the Inlay Lid.





When laying the site base, provide for the height of the Edge Protector (C). This will eliminate the need to cut extra depth into the site base at a later date.




EXISTING SITE

Remove existing drain cover components. Use the Edge Protector (C) as a guide and centre over the drainage pipe. Mark up allowing for extra 1-2mm clearance on all sides.









Push in Edge
Protector (C) until
is sits level with
surrounds.

Allow mortar to set.

3 INSTALL GROUT

Grout the Edge Protector (C) and allow to set.





NOTE - INSTALLATION IS ONLY COMPLETE WHEN:

REMOVE SAFETY KEY FROM LID

NEVER leave the HIDE Safety Key in the lid for any reason, especially after install. Leaving the Safety Key in an installed cover is a trip hazard and not child-safe. Avoid a possible accident or injury by removing the Safety Key.

PASS HOMEOWNER

PASS the Safety Key to the homeowner for secure storage. The "Home Owners Manual" packet should also be given to the homeowner.
